GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The summer photography intern is responsible for shooting photos of campers and staff for the end of session slide shows, bunkhouse photos and publications.

PROFESSIONAL SUPPORT: The intern will work closely with the Ranch Director to understand the operation of camp and to schedule coverage of program activities. The intern will also work closely with the marketing department to coordinate the collection of photographs and assess the quality of the photographs for marketing purposes.

PHOTOGRAPHY SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Shoot photos of bunkhouses and cabins at the beginning of camp
- Shoot photos of all major activities, free choice, church day and evening activities throughout each session
- Coordinate with staff members on the collection of photos from outcamp trips and additional pictures taken
- Edit and arrange the photographs into slideshows for staff banquets and end of camper session slideshows to be shown at each camp on banquet night.
 - One staff slideshow either at the beginning or end of the summer
 - One slideshows at end of session
- Work with the marketing department to label and organize photos as collected and regularly upload photos to the Denver office.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Live a demonstrated commitment to Christian Science
- Knowledge and experience working with digital camera
- Knowledge of composition
- Working knowledge of Photoshop or comparable photo editing software
- Working knowledge of digital slideshow software
- Independent worker with strong work ethic and initiative

HARDWARE NEEDED:

- A high quality digital camera provided by student.
- A laptop computer with Adobe Photoshop (plus Adobe Lightroom desired) for the photographer to edit photos and put together the slide shows.
- An external Hard drive is provided for storing photographs and transferring to Denver
