



CAMP 101 Travel Details

All participants (flying and driving) must complete our [online transportation form](#) so we can account for everyone attending our programs.

Driving to the A/U Ranches

Participants can plan to arrive at the A/U Ranches between 2:00 – 5:00pm on the first day of your program. For those using a GPS system, our address is: 18325 County Rd, #366, Buena Vista, CO 81211.

From Denver International Airport (DIA) to Buena Vista:

- Exit the Airport on Pena Blvd.
- Take I-70 West
- Exit on C470 (towards 285)
- Exit on to 285 (to Fairplay)
- Turn right after Johnson Village at the 285/24 intersection toward Buena Vista.
- Go through Buena Vista to County Rd 384 and turn left (at big yellow Jumpin' Goats Dairy sign)
- Then go to the first (and only) stop (CR361) and turn right.
- The A/U ranches are the very next left. You will see the gate over the road to the Ranches.
- Follow the signs to the Hub/Ranches office (approx. 2 miles from the gate) to check in.

Flying to Colorado

If you will be flying into Denver International Airport (DIA) and are planning on taking our van to the A/U Ranches, flight arrival times must be between 8:30am – 12:00pm and departures should be between 12:30pm – 4:00pm on the respective travel days.

Where to meet the A/U Ranches Staff at the Airport

If you are taking our van to the A/U Ranches, please follow airport signs to the baggage claim area which will include a short train ride. Upon exiting the train at baggage claim in the main terminal, go to Baggage Claim 19 where our staff will meet you.

NOTE: All A/U Ranches staff members will be wearing a navy blue polo shirt that says Staff and has an A/U emblem on the front.

It is important to carry your cell phone. Should plans change, or if we need to contact you, we will give you a call on the cell phone number you provided during registration.
